MORE LIKE JESUS

Often, Christians are told to just believe without thinking... it's called "having faith." But is this what God wants from us? To be mindless robots - having blind faith, following the rules, obeying without thinking and out of fear of what would happen if we didn't obey? Does God want us to be like slaves who just do what their master says because he says so, or does He want us to be His friends? "No longer do I call you slaves, *for the slave does not know what his master is doing*; but I have called you friends, for all things that I have heard from My Father I have made known to you." John 15:15 (NASU) I believe that God wants us to question, think, reason, trust and understand Him... like a friend. The Bible invites us to "come and reason" and even links this with cleansing and salvation (Isaiah 1:18). So, with that in mind, let's think through to understand the purpose of the cross. The following are phrases I've often heard or read, and questions that come to mind when I process what has been said:

"Jesus died on the cross so my sins can be forgiven."

Did Jesus's death do something to change God to be forgiving? Would God be unable/unwilling to forgive me if I don't know about Jesus? Isn't God always forgiving? Didn't Jesus even forgive those that crucified Him? Isn't God "more like Jesus"?

"Jesus had to die to pay the penalty for our sins."

Who is paid this penalty? Where does the penalty come from? God? Satan? Is sin a legal problem that requires an external force to inflict punishment for disobedience? Or is sin a terminal condition that breaks God's design for life and thus is a natural consequence of what happens when we are out of harmony with how life is suppose to operate?

"Jesus had to die to cancel our debts."

Wait... does he PAY or FORGIVE/CANCEL our debts? You can't forgive/cancel a debt that has been paid. If you owe me \$100 and then you pay it, it doesn't make sense for me to say, "Okay, I will forgive your debt now."

"God must punish sin."

Again, where does the penalty of sin come from? Does it come from God as an infliction for breaking His rules? Or as an inherent consequence for being out of harmony with the way God designed life to function? Should I be afraid of God or of sin?

"Jesus' sacrifice appeased the wrath of God."

Does Jesus save me from God? And what exactly is the wrath of God? Is Jesus forgiving and loving, but God is angry and judgmental? Can I trust Jesus, but not trust God? Aren't they supposed to be the same? Is God two-faced?

Can you answer these questions without saying, "I don't know, but I just have faith and believe even though I don't understand"? None of these questions are meant to undermine God, but to shed light on the harm in blind faith. How can you truly trust a God that you think is functionally saying, "Obey me and love me or else I'll kill you"? How can we truly know God and actually trust Him if we think that Jesus is saving us from what God would have to do to us if we didn't believe in Him and obey Him? I can tell you what helped me to answer these questions... shifting my understanding of God's law from an arbitrary, imposed set of rules to the design parameters for life to exist.
